However, when led effectively, meetings are the pathway to clarity, alignment, and increased results. In his best-selling book, *The Advantage*, Patrick Lencioni introduces the Weekly Tactical Meeting as the bedrock to healthy organizations. We've made this template to help you get started with this framework.

Key Concepts to Remember:

- **Thematic Goal:** The overriding number one objective of your entire company. Should be covered in every team meeting for alignment.
- **Defining Objectives:** The general categories of activity required to achieve the thematic goal. Typically 4-6 objectives provide enough scope without becoming distracted by peripheral priorities.
- **Standard Operating Objectives:** The tasks and priorities that don't relate to the thematic goal, but are necessary to keep your organization running.
- **Parking lot:** An area of the agenda to add any topics that take longer than 3 minutes to discuss. These topics will be moved to another meeting.






